


CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS at L&Q Living Schemes

Coxley House have been keeping up with their indoor exercise routines throughout this lockdown, which is great to see, keep up the good work team.




Festive music at BLH






Why Take Part?

'A fun way to stay fit' our classes improve strength, balance and co-ordination
'This class has helped my balance and I feel more confident.'

The classes can be danced seated in a chair or standing.



Do I need to book?

No booking required, just use the link provided.



How do I take part?

From January the classes take place online. We have dedicated 1-2-1 support to help get you online.

'Getting on Zoom was easier than I thought, you need a laugh when you're on your own.'



What happens in a class?

The classes start with a warm-up which includes a strength and balance exercises. The class then progresses on to learning dance, movement and routines supporting the body, brain and memory.

Each class is led by professional dance teachers, qualified to deliver dance to adults, 55+, 65+, learning disabled and people with low mobility. DanceWest teachers are trained in physiotherapy, dance psychotherapy; various dance styles, Yoga and Pilates.



Do I need experience to take part?

No experience needed, no specialist dance clothing or footwear needed.



I don't have a lot of space

Our classes are mindful of the limitations that come with dancing at home. We ensure that the routines and movement does not require specialist flooring and can be danced 'on the spot'.


